We kindly invite you to take part in the XVI Ural Demographic Forum “Factors and mechanisms of demographic development” (UDF-2025), which will be held in Ekaterinburg on 3–5 June, 2026.

UDF-2026 aims at enhancing scientific cooperation, exchanging experience and scientific results achieved by Russian and international researchers in the field of population science and related disciplines, improving research strategies, and offering practical recommendations concerning demographic development.

UDF-2026 will traditionally bring together representatives of the academia, authorities, public organizations focused on social, demographic and migration policy. As part of the event, the contest “Demography of the native region” and a workshop for young scientists will be held. At the workshop you will have the opportunity to present your research findings and receive feedback and recommendations from leading Russian experts in the field of demographic research (demographers, historians, sociologists, philosophers, economists).

The Proceedings of UDF-2026 will have been issued by the beginning of the Forum. All articles will be indexed in Russian Index of Science Citation (RISC). Publication of papers indexed in RISC is free of charge, no registration fee required. Individual articles (on the recommendation of the Organizing Committee) will be published in scientific journals included in the VAK list (K1): **AlterEconomics** and **Management Issues**.
